- कौटिलीय अर्थशास्त्र के अध्ययन से विघार्थी परिचित होंगे। इस प्रकार धर्म –दर्शन, आचार –व्यवहार,नीतिशास्त्र के मूल तत्वों को जानकर उत्तम चिरत्रवान मानव एवं कुशल नागरिक बनेगें। प्रस्तावित विषय –संस्कृत साहित्य की विविध विघाओ एवं वैदिकवाड़मय पर आधारित विषय पर लघु शोध कार्य से विधार्थीयों की शोधकपरक बुद्धि का विकास होगा। सर्वेक्षण, अन्वेषण एवं मनन चिन्तन से उनका बौद्धिक स्तर बढेगा साथ ही समसामयिक समस्या के निदान का मार्ग भी प्रश्रस्त होगा।
